The RCA has its immediate source in the Reformed Church in the Netherlands and other European countries. These churches grew out of attempts to reform the church in the sixteenth century guided by scripture and Martin Luther.

On the American continent, what began as the Reformed Dutch Church in the 1620s became the Reformed Church in America in 1867.

The RCA incorporates churches in Canada as well as the USA.

RCA Vision Statement: Our shared task is to equip congregations for ministry – a thousand churches in a million ways doing one thing – following Christ in mission, in a lost and broken world so loved by God.
